Treasurer

The Treasurer is the lead director of financial management and oversight, and they serve as a member of the Board of Directors. They are expected to regularly attend quarterly Board meetings as per the organization's Bylaws. The Treasurer takes the lead in ensuring the organization abides by its financial policies and creates systems to ensure transparency and accurate recordkeeping.

Financial policies and procedures have already been established for the organization, but it will be the responsibility of the Treasurer to amend such policies and procedures as they deem necessary.

It is also preferable for the treasurer to have knowledge in nonprofits, but this is a requirement that can be learned on the job. The most important aspect of the treasurer is someone who holds honesty and integrity in high esteem and who is committed to accuracy, transparency and timeliness.

Additionally, the Board recognizes that diversity matters and welcomes BIPOC people to feel supported in submitting their application for consideration.
